CANADIAN LABOUR CONGRESS

- **Essex Kent Mushroom, Essex Continental Dist. Inc., or Unionville Farms**
In support of Rol-Land Farms Inc. in Kingsville, Ontario who have chosen UFCW to represent them, however, the owner continues to refuse to recognize the union as the bargaining agent.
- **Philips Electronics Products**
Support for 125 members of United Steelworkers, Local 7812 in Saint-Jérôme (Québec) who have been employed at Philips for a number of years. The company is transferring its production to Brazil.
- **Old Dutch Snack Foods Ltd. (*excluding the Provinces of Quebec and New Brunswick*)**
Support for 170 members of United Food and Commercial Workers International Union, Local 401 who are locked-out waiting for Old Dutch Snack Foods Ltd. to negotiate a fair and equitable collective agreement.
- **U.S. Steel Canada Inc. - Declaration of "Hot Cargo"**
The CLC has undertaken a declaration of "**Hot Cargo**" against U.S. Steel Canada Inc. at its Nanticoke, Ontario facility. This declaration is at the request of the United Steelworkers (USW) and is in support of 1,000 locked out members of USW, Local 8782 waiting for U.S. Steel Canada Inc. to negotiate a fair and equitable collective agreement.
