JOE BIDEN SUPPORTS **COMMUTER RAILROAD WORKERS**

- Sponsored a bill that enabled widows of railroad workers to receive their spouse's full Tier II Railroad Retirement pension benefits¹
- Ensured that stimulus funding after the 2008 economic collapse went to rebuilding passenger railroad infrastructure²
- Stood with rail labor over his career³

JOE BIDEN SUPPORTS COMMUTER **RAILROAD INVESTMENTS**

His Clean Energy Plan will create good union jobs by:⁴

- Building and upgrading a **cleaner**, **safer**, **stronger** infrastructure, including municipal commuter railroad networks in rural and urban areas
- Providing high-quality, public transportation options with flexible federal investments and strong labor protections
- Funding the state-of-good-repair needs and capital infrastructure projects on existing commuter railroad and transit lines

JOE BIDEN FIGHTS FOR UNIONS

- Will check the abuse of corporate power over labor and hold corporate executives personally accountable for violations of labor laws⁵
- **Promotes collective bargaining for workers** under the Railway Labor Act and commits to a high standard for intervening in strikes⁶
- Guarantees that transportation investments meet commuter labor protections so that new jobs are good-paying jobs with family sustaining benefits⁷
- Supports the passing of an OSHA Emergency Temporary Standard, which require protections for frontline workers, and priority access to personal protective equipment and testing⁸

TRUMP HAS FAILED COMMUTER RAILROAD WORKERS

• **Put workers and riders at risk of COVID-19** by failing to enact mandatory cleaning, PPE and social distancing that would protect passengers and frontline workers¹

This adminstration's:

Federal Railroad Administration

• **Granted excessive safety waivers** during COVID-19 response, offering oversight only after rail labor pressure²

Federal Transit Administration

- Refused to issue a rule that would mitigate the increasing assault cases on U.S. public transportation workers²
- Proposed a rule change that would eliminate Davis-Bacon, 13(c) transit employee labor protections and Buy America on federal projects³

TRUMP'S ACTIONS HURT COMMUTER RAILROAD WORKERS

The President's budgets **slash funding** for public transportation

- FY2019 cuts USDOT funding by \$1.7B⁴
- FY2020 Trump proposed cutting Capital Improvement Transit Grants by \$1B⁵
- This administration's Department of Transportation withheld billions of dollars of funding for major commuter railroad projects, even though a bipartisan bill already passed that allocated the funding⁶
